### Summer Session 2024 Frequently Asked Questions

#### When will summer school be held?

The 2024 Blochman Summer Enrichment Program will operate June 17-July 12 (with 6/19 and 7/4 off) M-F from 8:30am-5:30pm. (Please pick up students by 5:15pm.)

# What will students be doing during the day?

Students will engage in academic skill work that addresses summer learning loss. The morning academics will focus on math and reading enrichment. The afternoons will be focused on STEAM topics, using a variety of individual or small and engaging group activities.

### Will transportation be provided to and from summer school?

YES. One bus will pick up and drop off students at First Christian Church parking lot. Pick up time is 7:45-7:55 AM (must be loaded no later than 7:55 AM.) Student drop off time is between 4:30-4:45PM.

# Will breakfast and lunch be served each day?

YES. Breakfast and lunch will be served daily in the cafeteria. Breakfast and lunch are free to all enrolled students that attend. Breakfast will be available from 8:45am-9:15am and Lunch is 12:30-1pm.. Snacks are served at the picnic tables by Room 1.

#### Will there be an incentive program?

Students will have the opportunity to win prizes through incentivizing good

choices, kind words or acts, and participation in activities. Students will receive tickets throughout the day and prizes will be drawn 2x/day for each class.

### How do I enroll my child for the summer enrichment program?

Simply fill out the enrollment form and sign the Parent Agreement form (one per family) after reading the Parent Student Handbook. The forms can be downloaded and printed from the school website under 'PARENTS' then 'Summer School Information'. Forms may be picked up in the school office. Forms should be turned in to the office or your student's teacher by May 20, 2024.

# Will there be a field trip or other special days?

Yes. We are planning a field trip on July 2nd to the Central Coast Aquarium in Avila. Students will be boarding a boat and learning about local marine life and boat safety. The boating experience will be from 10am-12pm. All enrolled students are eligible with signed parent permission slips. (More information to follow. There will also be a fun water day on the last day of Summer School.

#### Is my child required to attend?

No. You may choose to opt out of summer school by not enrolling your student(s.)

Enrollment is for the entire length of the Summer Session (17 days.)Please do not enroll if you are not committed to attending the full program schedule of June 17th-July12th.
